The passage of the Arizona Aggregate Protection Act (SB 1598) established a framework and new requirements for community planners and leaders to responsibly address one of the most critical elements affecting the viability of future development – the availability of affordable construction materials. SB 1598 creates a significant opportunity for counties, municipalities, and special districts to work productively with the mining industry to ensure the sustainable growth of our communities.
